RECYCLING PILL BOTTLES What do you do with your old prescription and over-the-counter pill bottles? Do you throw them away? Did you know you can help improve the quality of health care in hospitals and health clinics in developing countries by saving and donating pill bottles? In developing countries, medicines — when obtainable — are often dispensed into hands, pockets, leaves or any other available container. From June through August only, our LWML will be collecting pill bottles and sending them to Matthew 25: Ministries in Cincinnati, Ohio. They accept donations of clean, empty pill bottles to help improve health care quality in developing nations. Medicine can then be distributed in sterile containers to the poorest of the poor. Bottles not appropriate to include are recycled for cash that goes towards Matthew 25: Ministries' programs. Placing a nickel, dime, or quarter in each bottle helps with shipping costs. Acceptable bottles include: Prescription and over-the-counter pill bottles, bottles with and without secure (child resistant) caps. If possible please adhere to these guidelines: Bottles must have an all plastic lid, remove labels, leaving no glue or residue, wash bottles in very hot water and dish soap, thoroughly rinse and dry, replace lids on clean, dried bottles. Place bottles in the large red box in the narthex by August 31, 2018.
